No. F-5-20-2014-1-LV.—In exercise of the power conferred by Section 12 of the Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk Ka Nirdhnan) Adhiniyam, 2007 (No. 21 of 2007), the State Government hereby makes the following amendment relating to admission in "Madhya Pradesh Private Medical (M.B.B.S.) and Dental (B.D.S.) Under Graduate Courses Admission Rules, 2014"

AMENDMENT

In above rules,-

17 a-Cancellation of Admission:—

- (i) Cancellation of admission will mean, cancellation of admission of a candidate from the State Quota Seats due to any reason when the candidate vacates his/her seat willingly after having taken admission in any Private Medical/Dental College and such candidates will not participate in subsequent counseling.

It is clarified that if a candidate vacates a seat from one institution and takes admission in another institution within the State during the third round of counseling i.e. 6th September 2014 to 17th September 2014 this procedure would be termed as upgradation/reallotment, and this procedure will continue as was done earlier.

- (ii) Following instructions are issued in respect of cancellation of admission in the Private Medical/Dental Colleges :—

- (a) The admitted candidate who desires to vacate his/her seat will have to submit his/her application complete in all respect with valid reasons to the Director Medical Education and Dean/Principal of the concerned Institution. The candidate will have to submit along

with his/her application, the same photograph which was affixed during admission, copy of the allotment letter, and self attested copy of fee receipt. Applications complete as stated above will only be considered. Director Medical Education will having taken a decision, convey such decision to concerned Dean/Principal, concerned student, AFRC, MCI/DCI and concerned University. In cases where condition of seat leaving bond is applicable, the seat leaving bond amount shall have to be deposited, and then only such an application for cancellation of admission will be considered. The Director Medical Education will inform the concerned Dean/Principal regarding such cancellation of admission and the latter will return the original documents to the concerned Student/Guardian authorized by the student. Admission cancellation slip will be generated by Director Medical Education online through MPOnline only. Cancellation of admission done by the Director Medical Education only will be considered valid.

Procedure for obtaining Admission Cancellation Slip.—Director Medical Education will log-in through G2G on MPOnline portal whereafter the home page of Director Medical Education will be displayed. The link regarding admission cancellation will be displayed in the home page. On clicking this link a page will be displayed. On entering the students Roll No. of AIPMT/AIPDT 2014 and round of counseling and on submitting; the details regarding the candidate will be displayed. On clicking the option for cancellation and submitting by the Director Medical Education, the admission will be cancelled and admission cancellation slip will be generated, which can be obtained by the candidate from the Director Medical Education. The admission cancellation slip can also be obtained by the candidate through MPOnline portal by using his own Roll No. and password.

17 (b) Dean/Principal of concerned institution shall ensure submission of list regarding admitted students and students whose admission have been cancelled as below:—

- (i) Dean/Principal of concerned college shall submit list of admitted students and students whose admission have been cancelled by the institution till 05/09/2014 till 5:00 pm to the Director Medical Education in Annexure 15 through email and post/special messenger such that the information should necessarily reach Director Medical Education by 7:00 pm on 05/09/2014 itself.
- (ii) Concerned institutions shall ensure submission of list of admitted students and students whose admissions have been cancelled to the Director Medical Education through email and post/special messenger each day by 7:00 pm from 06/09/2014 onwards in Annexure 15 compulsorily.
- (iii) Concerned institutions shall ensure display of complete list of admitted students and students whose admissions have been cancelled, at least for one complete year on institution website as per Annexure 15. The said list shall be sent through email and post/special messenger compulsorily to the following:—
 - (a) Director Medical Education (dme12001@yahoo.com)
 - (b) AFRC (afrcmp@gmail.com)
 - (c) MPOnline (ashish.singh@mponline.gov.in)

- (iv) Dean/Principal of concerned institution shall ensure submission of complete list of admitted students and students whose admissions have been cancelled to the Director Medical Education M.P., concerned University, AFRC, MPOnline, MCI/DCI through email and post/special messenger within 7 days from the last date of admission as scheduled, in Annexure 15.
- (v) If the concerned institution fails to display complete list of admitted students and students whose admissions have been cancelled for one year continuously or if the complete list of admitted students and students whose admissions have been cancelled is not sent to the Director Medical Education M.P., concerned University, AFRC, MPOnline, MCI/DCI through email and post/special messenger from time to time as stipulated or if the institution cancels the admissions of students on their own, then strict legal action will be taken against the owner/owners of the said institution, Dean/Principal presuming that they have intentionally and willfully concealed the information in order to fill the State Quota vacant seats illegally.

Due to the sensitivity and importance of the admission process, students are advised to exercise due diligence before taking admission in order to avoid financial loss, as error on the part of the student may entail debarring the student from admission for a period of next three years in any Medical/Dental College against the State Quota Seats.
