THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (No. 3) BILL, 2015.

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidate Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2015-2016.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the sixty-sixth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2015.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees Eight Thousand Five Hundred Ninety One Crore Twenty One Lakhs Twenty Two Thousand Three Hundred towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2015-2016 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Issue of Rs. 85,91,21,22,300 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2015-2016.

Appropriation.

3. The sum authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
