THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (NO. 6) BILL, 2016.

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2016-2017.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Sixty-Seventh year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No.-6) Act, 2016.

Issue of Rs. 94,30,91,00,387 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2016-2017.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of rupees Nine thousand four hundred thirty crore Ninety-one lakh three hundred eighty seven only towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2016-2017 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
