**THE MADHYA PRADESH ADHIVAKTA KALYAN NIDHI
(SANSHODHAN) VIDHEYAK, 2019**

A Bill Further to amend the Madhya Pradesh Adhivakta Kalyan Nidhi Adhiniyam, 1982.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the seventieth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Adhivakta Kalyan Nidhi (Sanshodhan) Adhiniyam, 2019.

**Amendment of
Section 18.**

2. In Section 18 of the Madhya Pradesh Adhivakta Kalyan Nidhi Adhiniyam, 1982 (No. 9 of 1982), (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (1), for the words "twenty rupees and fifty rupees", the words "forty rupees and hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

**Amendment of
Section 19.**

3. In Section 19 of the principal Act,—

(i) in sub-section (1), for the words "twenty rupees", the words "forty rupees" shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-section (2), for the words "fifty rupees", the words "hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

At present Adhivakta Kalyan Nidhi stamps worth Rs. 50 and Rs. 20 are being affixed in the memo of appearance filed before the High Court and subordinate courts respectively.

2. The revenue received from the sale of these stamps are utilized for the implementation of welfare schemes of the Advocates. Due to high inflation the welfare schemes run under the Madhya Pradesh Adhivakta Kalyan Nidhi Adhiniyam, 1982 (No. 9 of 1982) are seriously affected. Hence it is proposed to increase the value of the stamp affixed under the principal Act from Rs. 50 to Rs. 100 in the High Court and Rs. 20 to Rs. 40 in the subordinate courts and in other authorities/Tribunals. Therefore suitable amendments are proposed in Section 18 and 19 of the principal Act.

3. Hence this Bill.
