THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION BILL, 2021

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2020-21.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Seventy-Second year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- Short title.** 1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Act, 2021.
- Issue of Rs. 1,67,71,97,17,163 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2020-21.** 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate inclusive of the sums in column (3) of the Schedule to the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Ordinance 2021 (No. 2 of 2021) to the sums of Rs. Sixteen thousand seven hundred seventy one crore ninety seven lakh seventeen thousand one hundred sixty three only towards defraying the several charges which shall come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2020-2021 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.
- Appropriation.** 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
- Repeal and Saving.** 4. (1) The Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Ordinance, 2021 (No. 2 of 2021) is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding the repeal of the said Ordinance, anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Act.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 204 (1) read with Article 205 of the Constitution of India to provide for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh of the moneys required to meet the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh and the grants made in advance by the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Ordinance, 2021 (No. 2 of 2021) in respect of estimate expenditure of the Government of Madhya Pradesh for the Financial Year 2020-21.

2. Since the matter was urgent and the Legislative Assembly was not in session, the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Ordinance, 2021 (No. 2 of 2021) was promulgated for this purpose. It is now proposed to replace the said Ordinance, without any modification by an Act of the State Legislature.

3. Hence this Bill.
