क्र. 162-रास-यू-5-2011.—मध्यप्रदेश पशु चिकित्सा विज्ञान विश्वविद्यालय अधिनियम, 2009 की धारा 43(1)(क) के तहत प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, महामहिम कुलाधिपतिजी द्वारा धारा 51(4) के अंतर्गत विश्वविद्यालय की वित्त समिति द्वारा संलग्न परिशिष्ट अनुसार तैयार किये गये एवं प्रबंध बोर्ड द्वारा अनुमोदित विश्वविद्यालय के कर्मचारियों के लिये स्ववित्तीय पेंशन/ग्रेच्युटी योजना एवं अंशदायी भविष्य निधि योजना संबंधी विनियमों पर अनुमोदन प्रदान किया गया है.

MADHYA PRADESH PASHU CHIKITSHA VIGYAN VISHWA VIDYALAYA, JABALPUR

REGULATIONS GOVERNING FOR PENSION, GRATUITY, COMMUTATION OF PENSION AND FAMILY PENSION TO THE EMPLOYEES OF MPPCVVV JABALPUR 2009

1. These Regulations governing for Pension, Gratuity, Commutation. of Pension and Family Pension, shall be made applicable to all officers, teachers, and service personnel as defined in the MPPCVVV Statutes 2009 (except the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor) provided that;

- (a) Persons were recruited before 01-01-2005 by the J. N. Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur; and
- (b) Persons have opted Scheme-B-Pension and Gratuity Scheme of JNKVV service Pension Rules 1987; and
- (c) Persons opted for Scheme-B or Scheme-A "Contributory Provident Fund Scheme" have already been accepted by the said Vishwa Vidyalaya in terms of notification *vide* No. Bud/Pensioin/94-95/8976 dated 31-12-1994.

2. These Regulations shall not be applicable to the following :—

- (a) Persons whose wages are paid from Workcharged and Contingencies.
- (b) Persons engaged on part time assignment or re-employment on contract.
- (c) Labourers engaged on time scales of pay or on daily or monthly wages.
- (d) Employees who opted Scheme-A "Employees Contributory Provident Fund Scheme" as per relevant provisions of JNKVV Additional Statutes 1989 and whose options for above scheme have already been accepted by the said Vishwa Vidyalaya in terms of notification *vide* No. Bud/Pensioin/94-95/8976 dated 31-12-1994.
- (e) Officers, teachers and Service Personnel who have been recruited on or after 01-01-2005 in JNKVV, Jabalpur / RVSKVV, Gwalior or MPPCVVV, Jabalpur.

3. In order to meet expenditure on Pension, Gratuity, Commutation of Pension and Family Pension disbursement to the retired employees and also to meet other incidental expenses on operation of the Scheme-B, a Pension and Gratuity Fund shall be created at Vishwa Vidyalaya level. The funds for the said scheme shall be generated out of the amount collected from subscription of monthly contribution of Provident Fund on account of Vishwa Vidyalaya share from each employee covered under Scheme-B for Pension and Gratuity.

4. The funds so generated and collected from each employee shall be invested by the Vishwa Vidyalaya in consultation with the Finance Committee of the Vishwa Vidyalaya, in the manner as it may determine as per Section 39(2) of the Act and shall be operated by the Comptroller of this Vishwa Vidyalaya.

5. A employee shall not be entitle to get Vishwa Vidyalaya share or matching contribution made by the Vishwa Vidyalaya towards Contributory Provident Fund invested as per Clause (4) above. However, at the time of retirement or in the event of his death during course of service, a employee or his nominee shall be entitle to get sum accrued own subscrition of Provident Fund and interest earned thereon.

6. The monthly contribution towards Contributory Provident Fund amount of each employee as Vishwa Vidyalaya share shall be fixed once in a year by the Finance Committee in the month of March every year and the amount so determined in respect of Vishwa Vidyalaya share shall be credited in the Pension and Gratuity Fund.

7. The amount of Pension and Gratuity Fund at the Vishwa Vidyalaya headquarters will be checked and audited by the Local Fund Accounts Department of State Government of Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior, through their Resident Auditors stationed at the headquarters of the Vishwa Vidyalaya.

8. All Officers, teachers and service personnel as defined in the Statutes 2009 of MPPCVVV, Jabalpur 2009 who have given option for Scheme-A before formation of this Vishwa Vidyalaya and their said option have already been accepted in terms of notification No. Bud/Pension/94-95/8976 dt. 31-12-1994 shall continue to be governed by CPF Scheme.

9. In case of any doubt or if any provision of this Regulation is ambiguous, then the provisions and terms conditions prescribed in the M. P. Civil Service (Pension) Rule, 1976 amended from time to time shall be finally applicable. Similarly disbursement of Pension Gratuity, Commutation or Pension and Family Pension etc. shall be regulated as per provision of M. P. Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1976 as adopted by this Vishwa Vidyalaya.

10. The Vice Chancellor shall be the final authority in all matters relating to pension cases where in a decision has to be taken regarding date of birth, qualifying service, admissibility of Pension and similar other issues.

MADHYA PRADESH PASHU CHIKITSA VIGYAN VISHWA VIDYALAYA, JABALPUR

REGULATIONS GOVERNING FOR CONTRIBUTORY PROVIDENT FUND TO THE EMPLOYEES OF MPPCVVV JABALPUR 2009

1. These Regulations governing for Contributory Provident Fund shall be made applicable to all officers, teachers and service personnel as defined in the Madhya Pradesh Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalaya Statutes 2009 (except the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor) who were recruited before 01-01-2005 by the J. N. Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur and serving in this Vishwa Vidyalaya w.e.f. 03-11-2009 and who opted Scheme -A- for Contributory Provident Fund Scheme Prevalent in J.N. Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya w. e. f. 01-04-1987.

2. These Regulations shall not be applicable to the following:—

- (a) Persons whose wages are paid from workcharged establishment or contingencies.
- (b) Persons engaged on part time assignment or re-employment in any capacity.
- (c) Labourers engaged on Time Scale of Pay or on daily or monthly wages.
- (d) Officers, Teachers and Service Personnel who have been recruited on or after 01-01-2005 in the JNKVV, Jabalpur / RVSKVV, Gwalior or MPPCVVV, Jabalpur to whom “परिभाषित अंशदान पेंशन योजना” as prevalent in the Govt. of M.P. has been made effective.

3. The Contributory Provident Fund shall be regulated by the Vishwa Vidyalaya and administered by the Committee of trustees comprising the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and Comptroller and atleast two members of the employees to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

4. The Vice-Chancellor or in his absence, the Registrar or in absence of the both, the Comptroller shall preside the meeting of the committee of Trustees. The presence of atleast three members shall be necessary to form a quorum for transaction of business. Each member shall have one vote and in case of equality of votes, the Presiding Officer shall have casting vote.

5. All money belonging to the Contributory Provident Fund shall be deposited with the nationalized or in such scheduled banks/Corporations/or such banks as per orders Issued by the deptt. of Finance Govt. of M. P. Bhopal vide No. स.अ./शा.पू.नि./1/सं.वि.सं./2008/1725, दिनांक 19-8-2008 as may be decided in this regard by the Committee of Trustees of the Vishwa Vidyalaya or invested in the Securities of State or Central Governments in the name of M. P. Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalaya Contributory Provident Fund A/C and shall be operated by one or more persons singly or jointly as may be nominated by the Committee of Trustees.

6. The Accounts of the Contributory Provident Fund shall be prepared yearly as at the 31st March and shall be audited by the Resident Auditors of the Local Fund Audit, a department of the State Govt. of M.P. or by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Vishwa Vidyalaya. The Balance Sheet of the Contributory Provident Fund Account shall be submitted to committee of Trustees of Vishwa Vidyalaya every year.

7. Each employee shall subscribe to the Fund at the rate of Ten Percent of his basic Pay or as may be fixed by the Committee of Trustees from time to time. Prescribed subscription shall be deducted from the monthly salary payable to the subscriber every month. The rate of subscription once fixed shall remain effective through out the year.

8. The Rate of interest on Contributory Provident Fund Account shall be fixed by the Committee of Trustees and credited in account of every subscriber based on balance monthly products of each subscriber's account during the preceding year.

9. The Comptroller on behalf of Trustees and with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor may grant a temporary advance/part final withdrawals in accordance with the provisions/rules applicable in the State Govt. of M.P. on the application of the subscriber provided the concerning Drawing and Disbursing Officer forward the same after due scrutiny.

10. The sum standing to the credit of a subscriber shall become payable his own subscription alongwith interest earned thereon in the event of his resignation, termination, dismissal, death, retrenchment and or retirement provided the subscriber fulfills the following requirements :—

- (a) The subscriber shall be required to submit a certificate towards No liability/ No dues outstanding from all concerned and certified by the controlling officer alongwith application for final withdrawal in the prescribed proforma.
- (b) In case of any legitimate liability or dues is outstanding against subscriber, the controlling officer shall issue specific order for recovery or dues showing the amount to be recovered from the subscriber and intimation to this effect be made available to the Comptroller of this Vishwa Vidyalaya simultaneously also mention the amount to be recovered from the final payment of C.P. Fund Account. Amount so recovered from the subscriber be deposited in the Vishwa Vidyalaya account.
- (c) The Comptroller with the approval of Vice Chancellor may issue a order towards final payment of a subscriber in the event of Regulation - 10, subject to fulfil the requirements as mentioned above.
- (d) In the event of death of a subscriber, a copy of death certificate issued by a competent authority and nomination submitted by subscriber during his live time will be essential alongwith other requirements. In absence of nomination, legal heir certificate issued by the competent authority will be required from applicant .

11. All expenses relating to the administration of the C.P. Fund including the pay and allowances of the staff appointed for the purpose of administering, the C.P. Fund shall be born by the Vishwa Vidyalaya and shall not be charged to the C.P. Fund Account.

To regulate the settlement of nominations, in the case of death of a subscriber, or in the cases of any other disputes, the rules of Provident Fund prevalent in the Govt. of M.P. shall be followed to resolve the disputes in the M.P. Pashu Chikitsa Vigyan Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur (M.P.)
