THE COURT-FEES (MADHYA PRADESH AMENDMENT) BILL, 2012.

A Bill further to amend the Court-fees Act, 1870 in its application to the State of Madhya Pradesh.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Sixty-third year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Court-fees (Madhya Pradesh Amendment) Act, 2012.

Amendment of Central Act No. VII of 1870 in its application to the State of Madhya Pradesh.

2. The Court-fees Act, 1870 (No. VII of 1870) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in its application to the State of Madhya Pradesh be amended in the manner hereinafter provided.

Amendment of Schedule II.

3. In Schedule II to the principal Act, in article 11, in clause (a), in sub-clause (i), in the column pertaining to proper fee, for the words “Ten percent of the enhanced amount claimed in appeal”, the words “Five percent of the enhanced amount claimed in appeal subject to a maximum of one lac rupees” shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In order to rationalize the court-fees leviable on memorandum of appeal when presented to the High Court by the claimant for enhancement of the amount of award passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, suitable amendment is proposed in article 11 of Schedule II to the Court-fees Act, 1870 (No. VII of 1870) in its application to the State of Madhya Pradesh.

2. Hence this Bill.
