THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2012.

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2012-2013.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Sixty Third year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 2012.

Issue of Rs. 51,71,69,91,252 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2012-2013.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Five thousand one hundred seventy one crore sixty nine lakhs ninety one thousand two hundred fifty two rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2012-2013 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
