MADHYA PRADESH MEDICAL SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES ENTRANCE TEST RULES-2013

Bhopal, the 6th September 2013

No. F 536/2012/1/55.—the State Government heereby makes following rules for Entrance Examination & Admission to superspeciality Courses in the State Government Autonomous Medical Colleges & for State Government quota seats in Private Medical colleges;

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES IN GOVT. AUTONOMOUS & STATE GOVT. QUOTA SEATS IN PRIVATE MEDICAL COLLEGES IN THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH

1. These rules may be called "M.P. Medical Superspeciality Course Entrance Test rules, 2013 for admission in Government Autonomous Medical Colleges & State Government Quota seats in Private Medical Colleges of Madhya Prdesh.

2. Courses, Institutions & Seats.

3- Eligibility

Requirement for admission to Super-Speciality (D.M./M.Ch.) Courses:-

- 3.1 The candidate must be citizen of India.
- 3.2 The candidate must have passed the Postgraduation (MD/MS/DNB) in the relevant subject on or before 30 August, 2013.
- 3.3 The candidate must have registration of M.D./M.S./DNB with Medical Council of India/State Medical Council.
- 3.4 The candidate holding DNB will be eligible for admission to superspeciality courses, provided they have done thesis work, evidence of thesis shall be produced by the candidate.
- 3.5 The candidate can apply for one or more courses as per their eligibility and give their preference choices for the Course and Institutions. (If available)
- 3.6 A candidate who has already acquired a superspeciality degree in any one discipline is not eligible to apply for any other discipline.
- 3.7 A candidate who is presently undergoing superspeciality course else where in any one discipline is not eligible to apply.

3.8 Eligibility qualifications for different courses shall be as given below in the Table:-

4- Duration of Course

The duration of superspeciality course shall be of three completed years including the period of examination.

5- The superspeciality (DM/M.Ch.) courses are full time courses. No candidate shall be allowed to do private practice, apply for/ or join any other course/ any post, once he/she has been admitted in a course till the course is completed.

6- Procedure for submission of application form and Fees

- 6.1 Duly completed Application shall be submitted in Directorate of Medical Education Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal by post/personal submission upto 17 September 2013, 5:00 pm. Applications received after last date and time will not be considered.
- 6.2 Demand Draft in favour of Director of Medical Education, payable at Bhopal, amounting Rupees 5000/- should be enclosed along with the application form.
- 6.3 Detailed instructions and application form will be available on Director Medical Education Bhopal website.

7. Entrance Test:

7.1 There shall be a written Entrance Test for all DM/M.Ch. courses to

be held on 22 September, 2013, Sunday.11.00 A.M.TO 1.00 P.M. at Gandhi Medical College Bhopal.

A candidate in order to become eligible for counselling and seat allotment must obtain minimum 50% marks in written entrance test.

8. <u>Mode of Entrance Test:</u>

- 8.1 There shall be one paper of 100 marks of two hours duration for each course.
- 8.2 The paper will be of Multiple Choice Questions(MCQ) type, each question having one correct answer.
- 8.3 There shall be no negative marking.
- 8.4 There shall be no mark awarded for more than one answers in one MCQ type question.

9. Declaration of Results

Merit list will be prepared of all eligible candidate on the basis of marks obtained in written entrance test.

- 9.1 In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks, the inter-se-merit of each candidate shall be determined in order of preference as follows:-
 - (i) The candidates who has passed the qualifying examination (MD/MS/DNB) in the first/less number of attempts will be given preference for admission.
 - (ii) If the number of attempts in MD/MS/DNB are same then the candidate who has got more aggregate marks, (taking into consideration marks of all the three professional examination of MBBS course to- gether) will be given preference for admission.
 - (iii) If the candidates are equally placed after 9.1(i) & 9.1(ii) then, the candidate older/oldest in age will be given preference for admission.
 - (iv) The merit list will be displayed on the notice board of Directorate of Medical Education, 6th floor, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal on 23rd September, 2013
- 9.2 The verification of Original documents & counselling will be held in the Directorate of Medical Education, 6th floor, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal on 23 September, 2013 from 11.00 AM onwards.

- 9.3 The Seat allotment would be made strictly on merit cum choice basis.
- The final result after counselling shall be notified on 23 September 2013.

10. Procedure for admission and payment of fees.

10.1 The candidates who have been allotted a seat shall have to take admission on the allotted DM/M.Ch course by the 27th September 2013, 5.00 P.M. in the allotted college and shall deposit the prescribed fees in the allotted institution. The fee detail of Private College is available on AFRC Madhya Pradesh website

Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the allotted course and their allottment shall be treated as automatically cancelled. The seat remaing vecant will be allotted to other candidates in the merit list and such candidate has to join the alloted course/college by 30th september 2013, 5.00 p.m.
