## MADHYA PRADESH MEDICAL SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES (DM/MCh.) ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND ADMISSION RULES—2016

No. F-5-61-2016-1-LV.— The State Government hereby makes following rules for Entrance Examination & Admission to Superspeciality Courses (DM/MCh.) in the State Government Autonomous Medical Colleges & for State Private Medical Colleges of State of Madhya Pradesh ;

### RULES

#### RULES FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND ADMISSION TO SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES(DM/MCh.) IN GOVERNMENT AUTONOMOUS & STATE PRIVATE MEDICAL COLLEGES IN THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH

1- These rules may be called “ M.P. Medical Superspeciality Course (DM/MCh.) Entrance Examination and Admission Rules, 2016 for admission in Government Autonomous Medical Colleges & in Private Medical Colleges State of Madhya Pradesh.

2-Courses, Institutions & Seats.—Tables showing availability of seats in various Superspeciality courses (DM/MCh.) for the academic session 2016-17.

## 3- Eligibility.—Requirement for admission to Super-Speciality (D.M./M.Ch.) Courses:-

- 3.1 The candidate must be Citizen of India.
- 3.2 The candidate must have passed the Postgraduation (MD/MS/DNB) in the relevant subject on or before 31 July, 2016.
- 3.3 The candidate must have registration of M.D./M.S./DNB with Medical Council of India/State Medical Council.
- 3.4 The candidate holding DNB will be eligible for admission to superspeciality courses, provided they have done thesis work, evidence of thesis shall be produced by the candidate.
- 3.5 The candidate can apply for one or more courses as per their eligibility and give their preference choices for the course and institution. (If available)
- 3.6 A candidate who has already acquired a superspeciality degree in any one discipline is not eligible to apply for any other discipline.
- 3.7 A candidate who is presently undergoing superspeciality course elsewhere in any one discipline is not eligible to apply.
- 3.8 Eligibility qualifications for different courses shall be as given below in the Table :-

Note- The candidates are advised to ensure the status of seats whether permitted or recognized in different institutions by MCI which is displayed on MCI Website. Directorate of Medical Education will not be responsible for the status of seats.

4. **Duration of Course.**—The duration of superspeciality course shall be of three completed years including the period of examination.

5. The superspeciality (DM/M.Ch.) courses are full time courses. No candidate shall be allowed to do private practice apply for/ to join any other course/ any post, once he/she has been admitted in a course till the course is completed.

#### 6. Procedure for submission of application form and Fees

- 6.1 Detailed instructions and application form will be available on Director of Medical Education, Bhopal website. [www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in](http://www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in)
- 6.2 Duly completed Application form (Annexure-I) shall be submitted in Directorate Medical Education 6<sup>th</sup> Floor Satpura Bhawan Bhopal by post/ personal upto 5:00 pm, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016. Application received after 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016 will not be accepted.
- 6.3 Demand draft in favour of Director of Medical Education, Payable at Bhopal amounting Rupees 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) should be enclosed along with the application form.
- 6.4 A list of eligible candidates for the entrance examination will be displayed on Director Medical Education, Bhopal website [www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in](http://www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in)

#### 7. Entrance Examination.

- 7.1 There shall be a written common Entrance Examination for all DM/M.Ch. courses to be held On 10<sup>th</sup> July , 2016 Sunday, 11.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. at Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal. Admit card for the entrance examination will be issued to all candidates before commencement of examination at the examination centre Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal. Candidates must reach the examination centre Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal, two hour before the commencement of examination.

A candidate in order to become eligible for counselling and seat Allotment must obtain minimum 50% marks in written entrance Examination.

A candidates must have obtained minimum 50% qualifying marks in the written examination to be eligible for counseling and allotment as per merit

#### 8. Mode of Entrance Examination :

- 8.1 There shall be one paper of 100 marks of two hours duration for each course.
- 8.2 The paper will be of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) type, each question having one correct answer.
- 8.3 There shall be no negative marking.
- 8.4 There shall be no mark awarded for more than one answers in one MCQ type question.

9. **Declaration of Results.**—Merit list will be prepared of all eligible candidates on the basis of marks obtained in written entrance Examination.

- 9.1 In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks, the inter-se-merit of each candidate shall be determined in order of preference as follows :—
- (i) The candidate who has passed the qualifying examination (MD/MS/DNB) in the first/less number of attempts will be given preference for admission.
- (ii) If the number of attempts in MD/MS/DNB is same then the candidate who has got more aggregate marks, (taking into consideration marks of all the three professional examination of MBBS course to-gather) will be given preference for admission.
- (iii) If the candidates are equally placed after 9.1 (i) & 9.1 (ii) then, the candidate older/Oldest in age will be given preference for admission.

- (iv) The merit list of qualified candidates will be displayed on DME Notice Board/ Website [www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in](http://www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in) on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2016

- 9.2 The verification and scrutiny of Original documents & counseling will be held in the Directorate of Medical Education, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Satpura bhawan, Bhopal on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2016
- 9.3 The seat allotment will be made strictly on merit cum choice basis.

10. Procedure for admission and payment of fees.—

- 10.1 The candidates who have been allotted a seat shall have to take admission on the allotted DM/M.Ch. course between 18<sup>th</sup> July to 20<sup>th</sup> July 2016 **between 11.00 A.M. till 5.00 P.M.** in Directorate of Medical Education, 6th floor, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal and shall deposit the prescribe fees & Original documents at the time of admission. The fee detail of Private College is available on AFRC Madhya Pradesh website. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the allotted course and their allotment shall be treated as automatically cancelled.

The candidate has to join the admitted institute between 1<sup>st</sup> Aug. to 7<sup>th</sup> August 2016 as per time schedule given by Hon'ble Supreme Court, as the commencement of session will start as per schedule of Hon'ble Supreme Court , w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016.

The Second round of Counseling for the seats remaining vacant will be conducted on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> August 2016 and the candidate who is allotted a seat, has to take admission on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> August 2016 between 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM in Directorate of Medical Education, 6th floor, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal by depositing the prescribed fees & Original documents on or before 12<sup>th</sup> August 2016 between 11.00 A.M. till 5.00 P.M.

The fee detail of Private College is available on AFRC Madhya Pradesh website. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the allotted course and their allotment shall be treated as automatically cancelled.

The candidate has to join the admitted institute by 27<sup>th</sup> August 2016 as per time schedule given by Hon'ble Supreme Court.

11- **Seat Leaving Bond.**—After taking admission on the allotted seat ( Govt./Private) candidate has to submit an affidavit stating that he/she will complete the course and will submit a seat leaving bond. Stating that if he/she resigns on the seat due to any reason on the date of commencement of last round of counseling or thereafter and before the completion of the course, he/she will have to deposit Rs. 10.00 lakhs (Rs. Ten lakhs) to the Autonomous society of concerned Govt. college and Director of Medical Education, M.P. Bhopal in case of Private unaided Medical College as financial penalty or else it will be recovered as land revenue arrear. Only then original documents will be returned to the candidate.

12. Any modification or clarification of the above rules and any further instruction to the candidates will be posted in the Director Medical Education Bhopal website [www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in](http://www.medicaleducation.mp.gov.in). Therefore it is advise that the candidates should check the above mentioned website on regular basis.

13. The State Government reserves rights to make any further amendment to rules if required.
