THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (No. 4) BILL, 2018.

An Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2018-2019.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Sixty-Ninth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 2018.

Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of rupees Eleven thousand one hundred ninety crore thirty four lakh fourty seven thousand seven hundred only towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2018-2019 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Issue of Rs. 1,11,90,34,47,700 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2018-2019.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
