THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION(No. 2) BILL, 2022

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2022-2023.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Seventy-third year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2022.

Issue of Rs. 27,92,36,81,34,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2022-23.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs. Two lakh seventy nine thousand two hundred thirty six crore eighty one lakh thirty four thousand towards defraying the several charges which shall come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2022-2023 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 204 (1) of the Constitution of India to provide for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh of the moneys required to meet the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh and the grants made by the Legislative Assembly for expenditure of the Government of Madhya Pradesh for the Financial Year 2022-23.
