MADHYA PRADESH BILL

THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (No. 2) BILL, 2023

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2023-2024.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Seventy-fourth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2023.

Issue of Rs. 31,40,24,83,54,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2023-2024. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs. Three lakh fourteen thousand twenty four crore eighty three lakh fifty four thousand towards defraying the several charges which shall come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2023-2024 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
