THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION BILL, 2024.

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2023-24.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Seventy-fifth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation Act, 2024.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs. Thirty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Five Crore Fifteen Lakh Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Forty Two towards defraying the several charge which shall come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2023-24 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
