THE MADHYA PRADESH APPROPRIATION (NO. 6) BILL, 2024

[Received the assent of the Governor on the 24th December, 2024; assent first published in the "Madhya Pradesh Gazette (Extra-ordinary)", dated the 25th December, 2024.]

A Bill to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh for the services of the Financial Year 2024-2025.

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Seventy-fifth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Appropriation (No. 6) Act, 2024.
- Issue of Rs. 2,24,60,18,06,621 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the Financial Year 2024-2025.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs. Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Crore Eighteen Lakh Six Thousand Six Hundred Twenty One towards defraying the several charges which shall come in the course of payment during the Financial Year 2024-2025 in respect of services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Madhya Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
